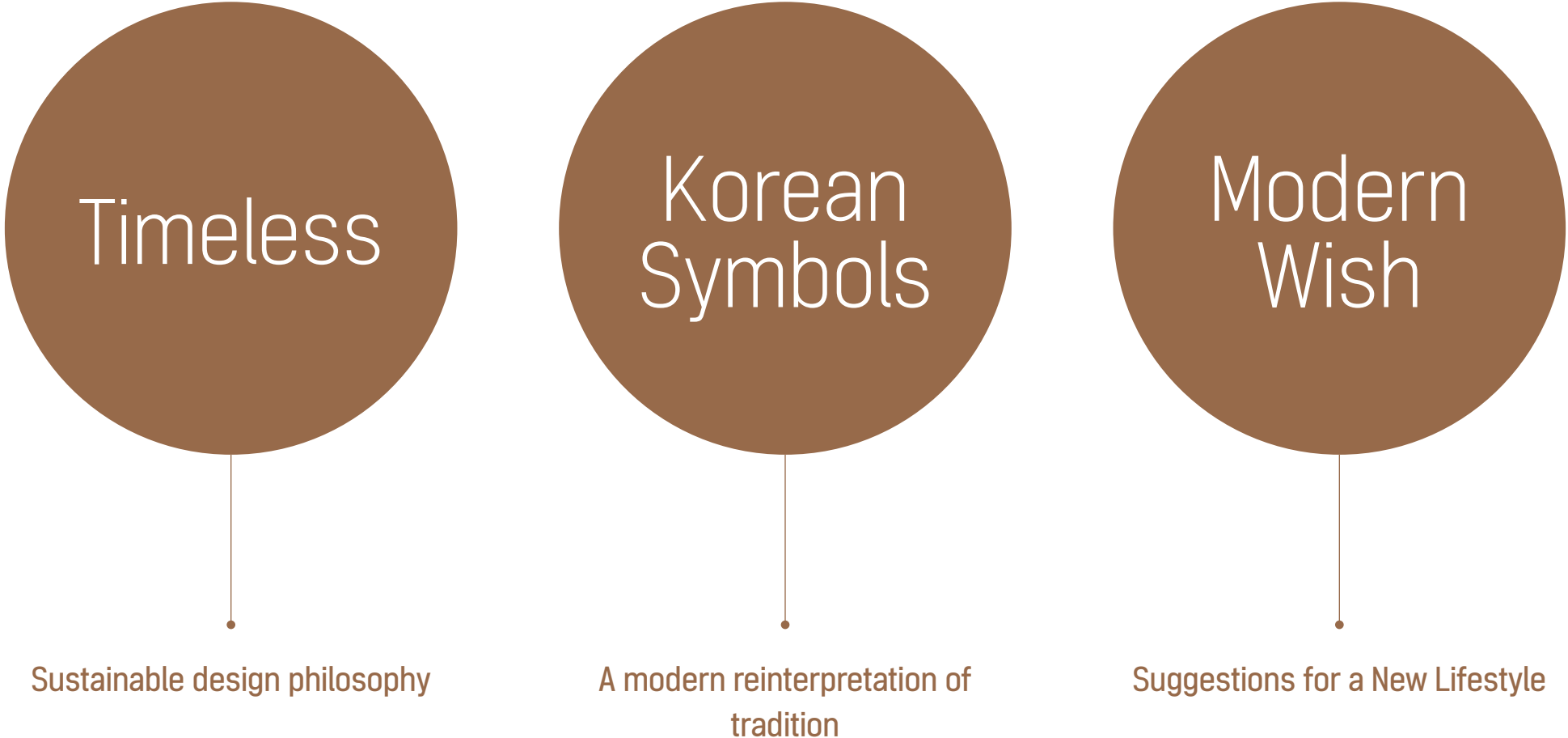

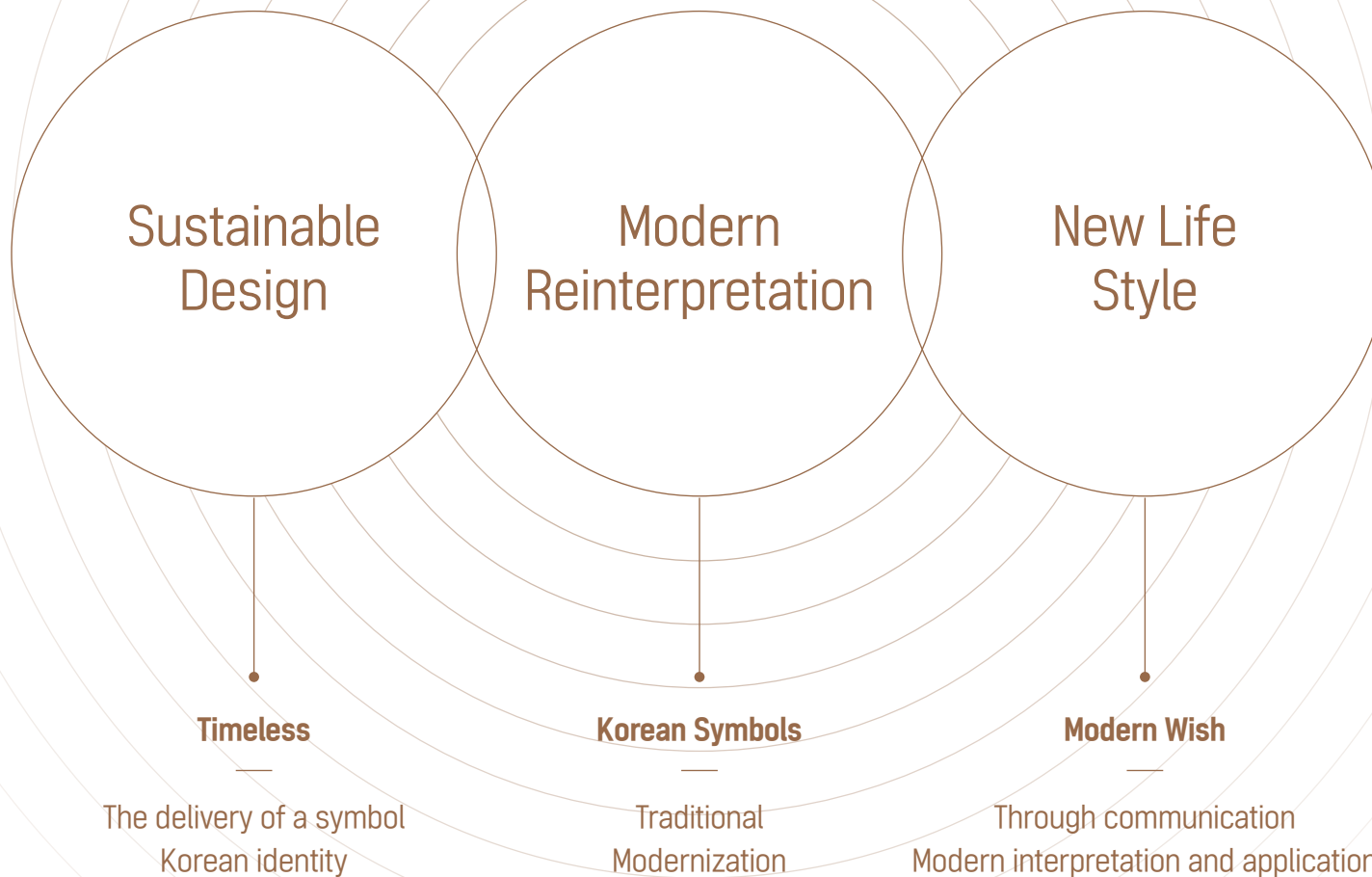

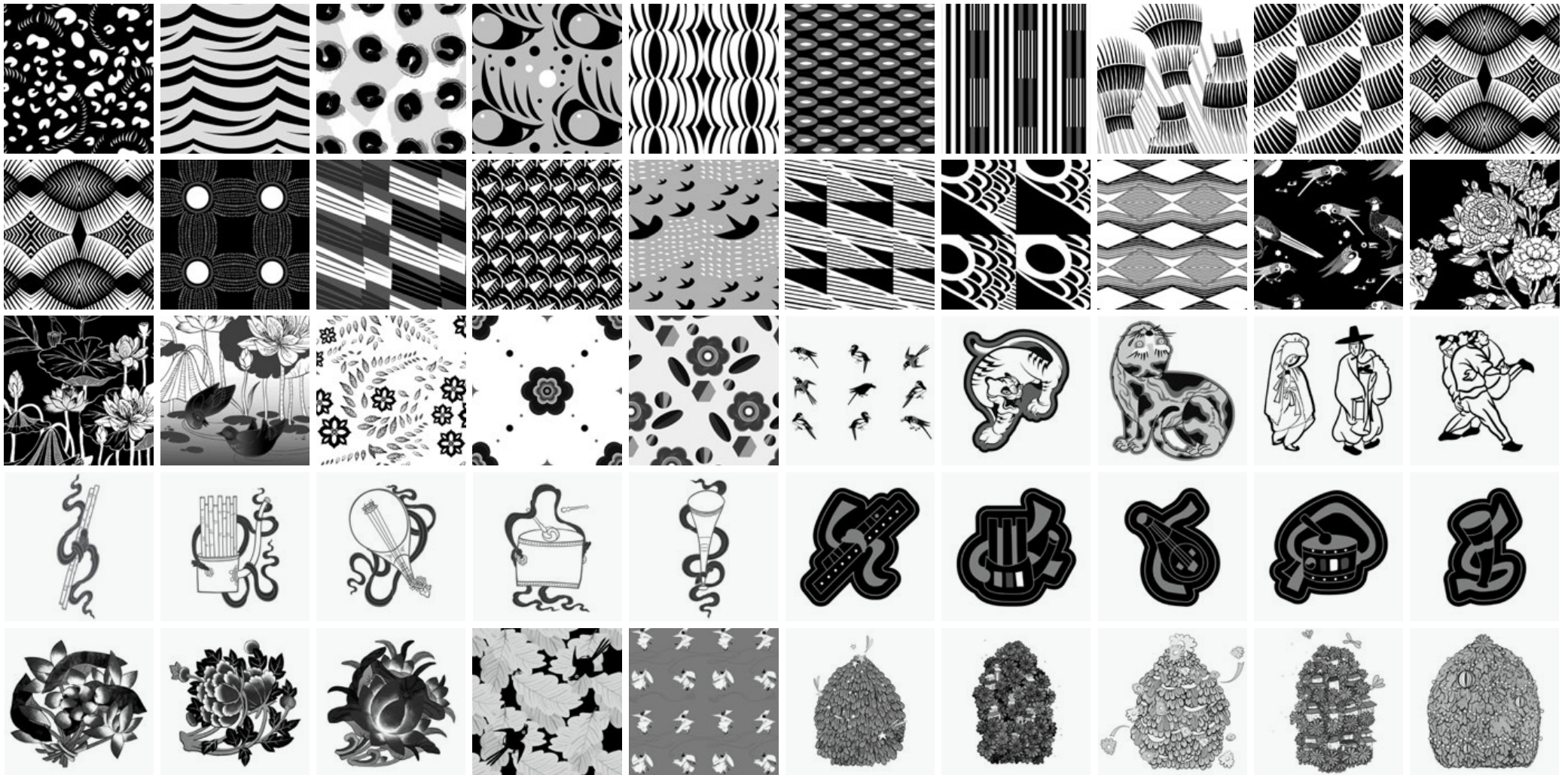

Patented image pattern process



Hojakdo

This pattern is a modern interpretation of the tiger and magpie from Hojakdo, expressed through geometric and repetitive forms. By analyzing the symbolic meaning and formal characteristics of traditional painting, a modular pattern design was developed, leading to the acquisition of a design patent.

BSOLart advances traditional minhwa into contemporary design elements, presenting new possibilities for the sustainable utilization of national cultural heritage.

In Korean Minhwa, the tiger has long been cherished as a symbol of protection, believed to ward off negative energy and safeguard people. Reinterpreting the tiger's powerful and reassuring presence through a knitted pattern, this blanket combines a soft, cozy texture with the meaning of protection and comfort, offering a moment of relaxation and warmth at the end of the day.



Product Kkachi (Magpie) Coaster

In Korean Minhwa, the magpie is regarded as a symbol of good fortune, bringing joyful news and welcoming guests. Inspired by the magpie's body and wing motifs, this knitted coaster adds a meaningful touch to moments of hospitality, expressing the warmth of welcoming others and the wish for cherished connections.

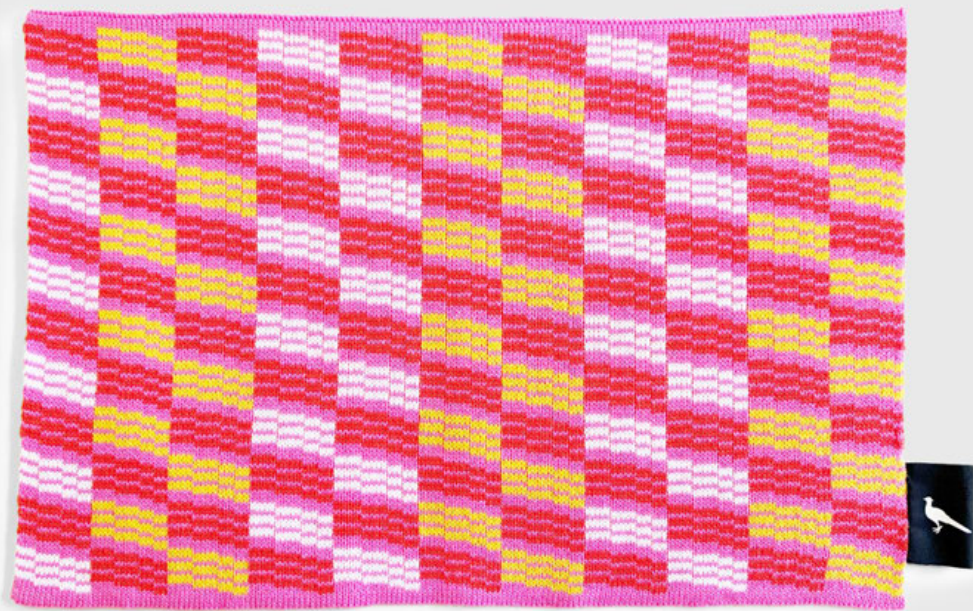


Product Dalgoo (Rooster) Muffler

By analyzing the formal characteristics and symbolism of Buddhist art, the design translates traditional elements into a contemporary visual language where tradition and modernity coexist. Beyond simple adaptation, the design focuses on reconstructing the intricate compositions and symbolic color meanings of tanghwa with a modern sensibility, preserving sacredness while enhancing practicality.

Additionally inspired by Dancheong motifs, the plant patterns reflect Korea's unique aesthetic that values inner spirit. 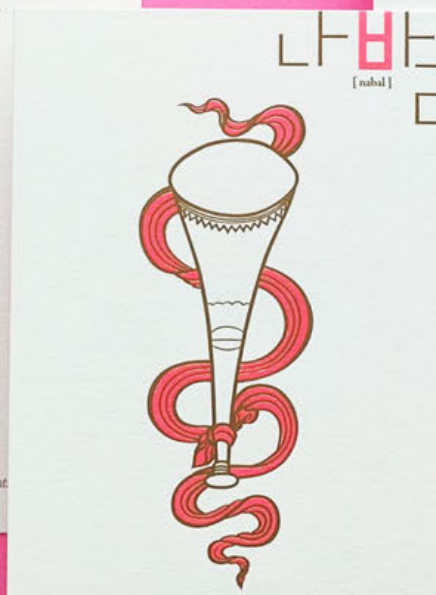

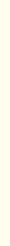

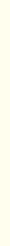
